QUESTION: Shall Section 1 of Article II of the Constitution be amended so as to change the minimum age for qualified voters of the State from twenty-one to eighteen? QUESTION: Shall the Constitution be amended to include in the definition of "city" any incorporated community which became a city as provided by law before noon on July 1, 1971?
