

Statement of the Whole Number of Votes Cast For and Against Certain Proposed Amendments to the Constitution of Virginia

At an election held on Tuesday, November 6, 1962

No. 1—QUESTION:

Shall section twenty of the Constitution of Virginia be amended so as to provide that an applicant for registration in order to vote shall make application to register on a form which may be provided by the registration officer?

No. 2—QUESTION:

Shall section fifty-a be added to the Constitution of Virginia so as to authorize the General Assembly, in case of enemy attack by nuclear fusion or fission bombs or devices and after proclamation of the Governor, to enact legislation by vote of less than a majority of the members elected, with such legislation to be effective for not more than one year?

No. 3—QUESTION:

Shall section thirty of the Constitution of Virginia be amended so as to authorize the General Assembly to require in every referendum required upon the issuance of State or local bonds that every voter therein shall be a freeholder of land within the State or political subdivision to be obligated, as requisite, and the General Assembly shall decide who shall be a freeholder for such purpose?
