OFFICIAL STATEMENT OF THE WHOLE NUMBER OF VOTES CAST IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA FOR AND AGAINST CERTAIN PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF VIRGINIA AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 1970.

PROPOSAL NO. 1

MAIN BODY OF THE CONSTITUTION

QUESTION: Shall the Constitution be generally amended and revised, as agreed to by the General Assembly at its 1969 and 1970 sessions (except for the three proposals separately stated below)?

PROPOSAL NO. 2

LOTTERIES

QUESTION: Shall the Constitution be amended by repealing Section 60 (which prohibits lotteries), leaving it to the General Assembly to decide whether to authorize or prohibit lotteries?

PROPOSAL NO. 3

GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

QUESTION: Shall the Constitution be amended to permit the General Assembly, subject to approval by the people in a referendum, to authorize general obligation bonds for specific capital projects, the total not to exceed 1.15 times the annual income and sales tax revenues of the Commonwealth?

PROPOSAL NO. 4

REVENUE BONDS

QUESTION: Shall the Constitution be amended to permit the General Assembly, by a 2/3 vote, to pledge the full faith and credit of the Commonwealth to revenue bonds issued for revenue-producing capital projects if the Governor certifies that the anticipated revenues from such projects will be sufficient to pay principal and interest as they become due, the total not to exceed 1.15 times the annual income and sales tax revenues of the Commonwealth?

NOTE: The figures in the column "PV" are provisional votes cast by persons voting under the shortened residency requirement and ordered to be kept separate by the Court.
