Conventions were held in the Sixth, Eighth and Ninth Districts to select the nominees.

There were no primary elections held in the First, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Seventh and Tenth Congressional Districts as only one candidate filed in each district and was declared the nominee without opposition subject to the November 5, 1968 General Election.
