* Senator Harry Flood Byrd, who was serving his sixth term in the United States Senate, resigned on November 11, 1965, citing failing health. Governor Albertis S. Harrison, Jr., next day appointed the Senator's son, Harry F. Byrd, Jr., 50, to fill the Senate seat until the next regular election in November, 1966. The Democratic State Central Committee met on February 19, 1966, and passed a resolution stating the nomination of the candidate of the Democratic Party would be made at this July 12, 1966, Primary Election for this unexpired term.
