Conventions were held in the Sixth, Eighth and Ninth Congressional Districts.

There were no primary elections held in the First, Second, Fourth, Fifth, Seventh and Tenth Congressional Districts for Member of the House of Representatives as the incumbents were unopposed.

It was not necessary to hold a state-wide primary as Senator Harry F. Byrd was the only candidate to file for the Office of United States Senator and was declared the nominee.
